

FINANCIAL RESOURCES INFORMATION

We understand not all campers may be able to afford the total cost of camp. We want campers to have access to all the benefits a week at camp offers regardless of financial circumstances. Please find financial resources below should you need assistance to pay for some or all of your camp fees.

Third-Party Funding

Some campers may receive resources from state-funded waiver programs or provider services such as respite programs or day services programs. These dollars can also be allocated to summer camp and we work with providers to set-up your agency to be billed for your summer camp costs. Below is a list of providers we have current contracts with, but we are willing to work with any provider that isn't on the list. In order to register a Camper for Ranch Camp, we will need a **Letter of Authorization** from a camper's case manager stating they will issue money to pay for the camper's sessions at camp. Ranch Camp will then bill that provider for the camper's camp fees.
